The acronym OPCA stands for "Organization for the Poor Community Advancement." Established in 1992, OPCA is a local, non-governmental, and non-political organization based in Bangladesh. It is registered with the MRA, NGO Bureau, Department of Social Welfare and Youth Development. OPCA has been actively engaged in the development sector, focusing on sustainable solutions and entitlements for impoverished communities. Its initiatives include Microfinance, Protection, Education, Health, WASH, Skill Development, Youth Empowerment, Agriculture and interventions for individuals with disabilities. Currently, OPCA receives funding from several organizations, including PKSF, Anukul Foundation, BRAC, CDD, and DAM.

OPCA will implement a project titled "Eastern Flood Response: GBViE" in the Feni district. This initiative will receive technical support from ActionAid Bangladesh and be funded by UNFPA Bangladesh. The project is set to run for **two months**, specifically in November and December 2024, with the possibility of extension for an additional 2-3 months, depending on funding availability. To ensure the successful implementation of the project, OPCA is seeking a suitable candidate for the position of "Outreach Worker".

The Outreach Worker (OW) will be responsible for conducting outreach sessions, assisting the team in distributing dignity kits, and maintaining communication with local leaders, Imams, and government offices. The position will report to the **Local Field Support Associate**, and it is open exclusively to **female** candidates.
